



People with deafblindness

Rights are the things that every person should have or be able to do, by law.



Deafblindness is a disability where you have a serious difficulty with both your hearing and your eyesight.



We want people with deafblindness to have the same rights and the same chance to make the most of their lives as everyone else.



We share information around the world about deafblindness.



We support and help organisations of people with deafblindness.

Deafblindness



Deafblindness is where you have a serious difficulty with both your hearing and with your eyesight.

Deafblindness is a disability that is different from other disabilities.



Deafblindness makes it hard to:

• meet up with friends and family.



• share information, ideas and feelings with people.



• get the information you need.



• move around safely.



Touch

People with deafblindness often share information, ideas and feelings by touching.

How many people have deafblindness?



Nearly 2 out of every 100 people have deafblindness.

This is over 600 million people in the world.



Most of these people have deafblindness because they are getting old - over age 75.



Some people have severe deafblindness. This is where you have very little or no hearing and eyesight.



Other people have mild deafblindness. This is where you have some hearing and some eyesight.




People with deafblindness

- not have much money.
- not have a job.
- not do very well at school.

 share information about good ways to support and help people with deafblindness.


